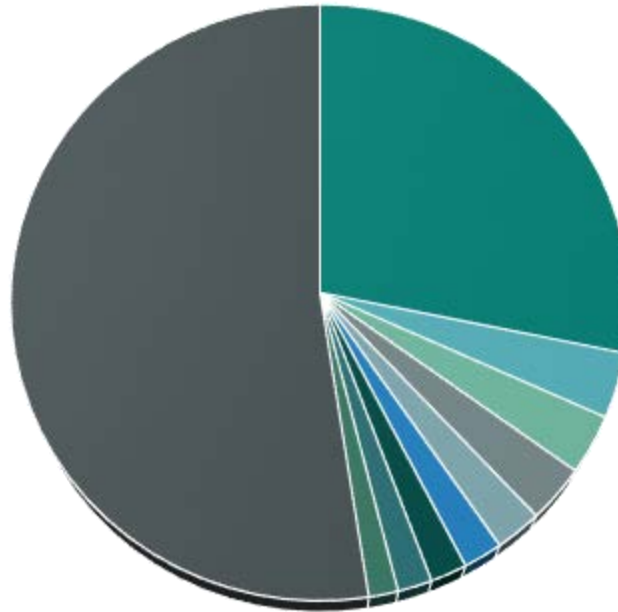

Top 10 countries who follow Crawford Fund



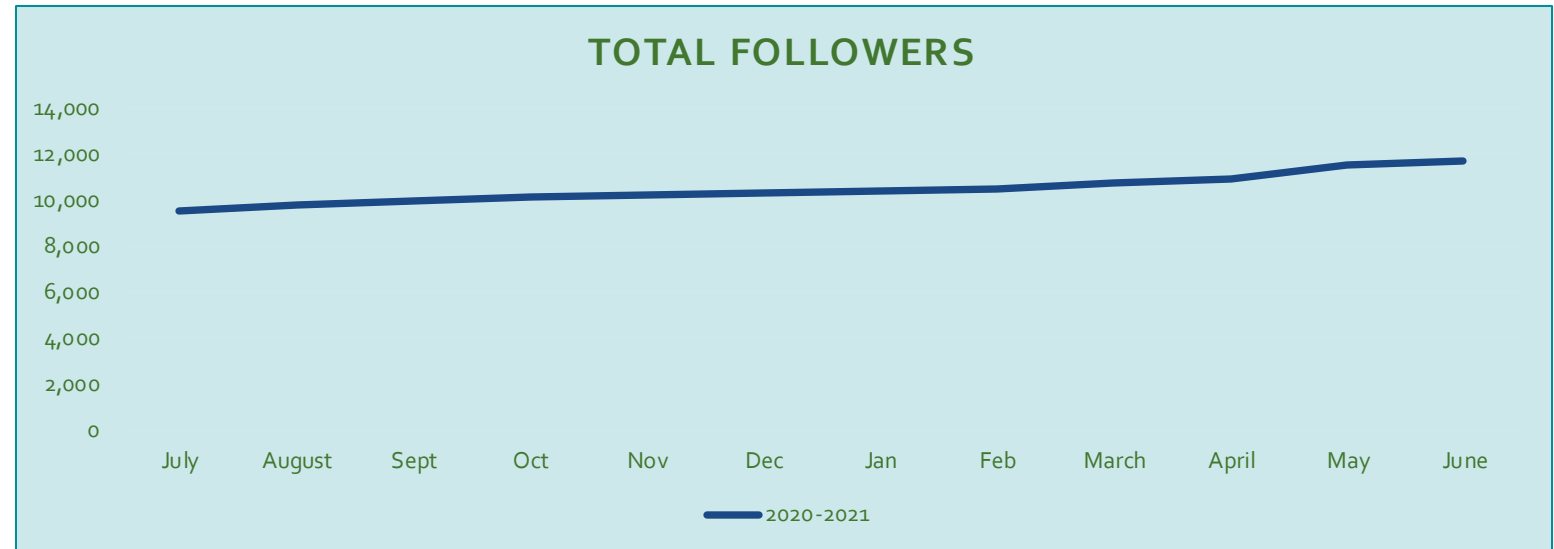

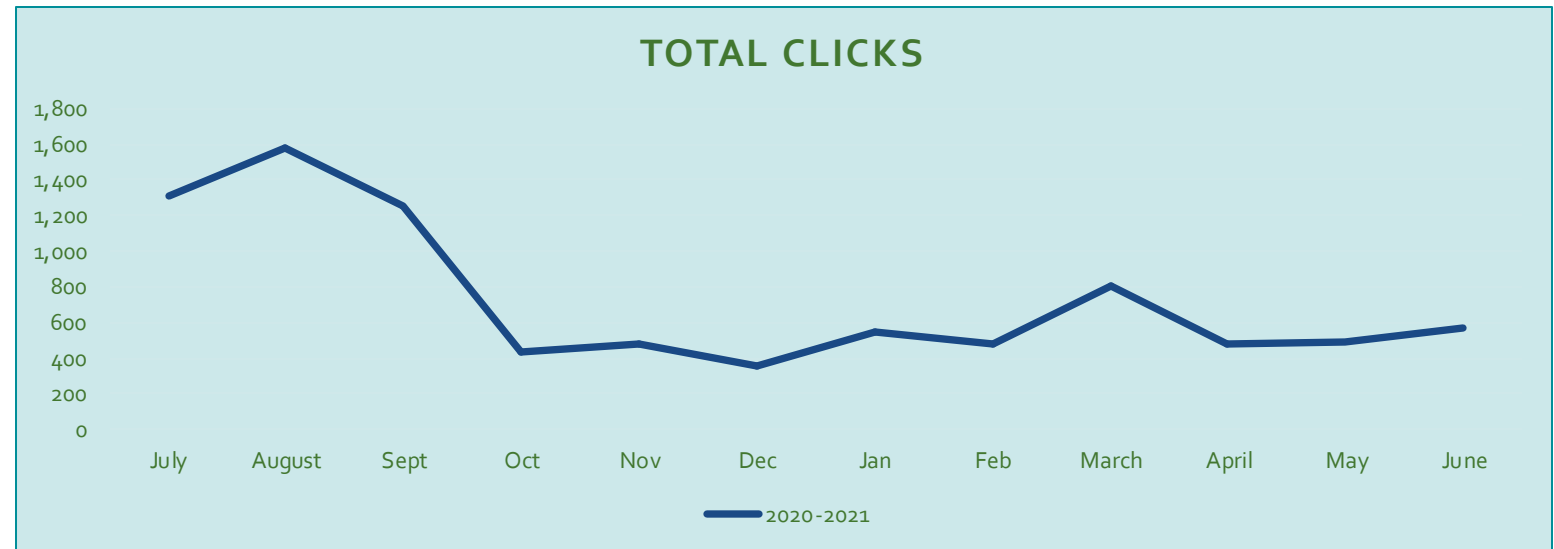
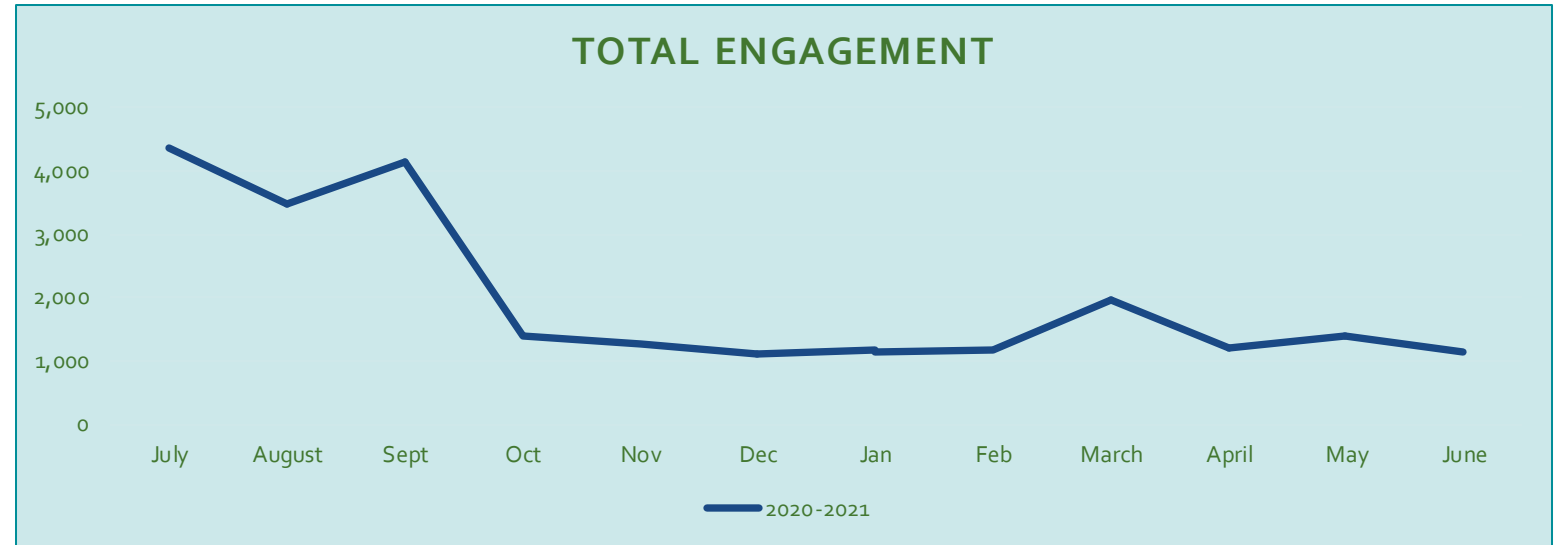
